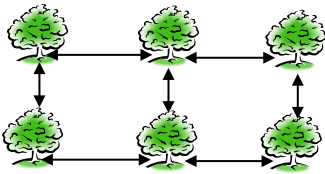

#### Who Can Apply?

All Manitobans are eligible for the Trees for Tomorrow planting program, including the following groups:

Landowners	Non-profit organizations
Municipalities	First Nations

#### When do you offer the trees?

The Hybrid Poplars are usually planted between May and June of each year.

The Conifers (ex: White Spruce) are usually planted between May and September of each year.

#### If accepted, what does the landowner (applicant) have to provide?

##### For Free Tree Giveaways:

Show up at the event location to pick up your free trees. Some events may have a maximum limit/person, so please call ahead for larger tree orders. A signature is all that is required (this application form is optional).

##### For the Small Scale Program:

Planting is the landowner's responsibility (although some limited assistance may be available on a case by case basis). Care and maintenance of the trees are the landowner's responsibility.

##### For the Large Scale Plantings:

We will consult and jointly develop a plan with you for your project. Planting assistance may be available. Care and maintenance of the trees are the landowner's responsibility. (Some maintenance assistance may be available for the first 3 years).
